| WISCONSIN | Academic instruction may start <br> any time after September 1. |  |

| IOWA | Law states: "The school year shall <br> begin on the first day of July and <br> each regularly established <br> elementary and secondary school <br> shall begin no sooner than a day <br> during the calendar week in which <br> the first day of September falls but <br> no later than the first Monday in <br> December.
